

Blues and purples in Demonstrations/Illustrated Talks, Project Talks, Drama: Readings & Public Speaking (Topic at KSF will be "How has your journey in 4-H contributed to being Beyond Ready for current challenges and future goals?") given by 4-H members 9 years and older by January 1 of the current 4-H year are eligible to go to the Kansas State Fair. An email will be sent to those who qualified. Pre-entries for Kansas State Fair presentations will be due July 1.

**Regional Qualifiers:** This year, run-offs for Regional 4-H Club Day will only be needed for the two rooms of Project Talk and the two rooms of Jr. Demonstrations/ Illustrated Talk presentations. If you receive a purple on a project talk and/or Jr. Demonstrations/ Illustrated Talk you may choose to present your presentation again for a chance to represent the District at 4-H Regional Club Day. **Regional run-offs for Jr. Demonstrations/ Illustrated Talks will begin at approximately 12:00 p.m. and run-offs for Project Talks will be at approximately 1:00 p.m.** Don't forget to check to see if you've made the run-offs because if you've made the run-offs, you will need to sign up for a time. In all other presentation and talent areas, Regional Qualifiers will be designated in the results posted.
