Fair is almost here!!!! Thanks so much for volunteering to serve as a superintendent or assistant superintendent for Visual and Performing Arts. Your time will be well spent and greatly appreciated.

Please read the following closely.

The **VISUAL Arts** (Fine Arts, Clay & Ceramics, Leather & Jewelry, 3-Dimensional, General Crafts) will be judged on **Wednesday, August 4, 8:00 a.m., 4-H Building**. Four judges have been hired for judging all mediums. **4-H Members will individually sign up for judging times online, Sunday, August 1. 4-H members who do not sign up for a judging time will lose one ribbon placing on their item(s)**. Items will be exhibited after they have been judged.

The **PERFORMING Arts** (dance, music, puppets) will be judged on Friday, August 6, 4-H Building. A judge has been hired for judging. All entries have been scheduled individually based on the pre-entries submitted. We ask that individuals check-in 10-15 minutes before their scheduled time. All performances will be presented in the open area. Contestants are responsible for their own equipment.

Visual/Performing Arts Superintendents and Assistants Roles and Responsibilities During the Fair:

- * **Visual Arts: 7:30 a.m. Performing Arts: 8:30 a.m.** Be ready to set-up judging tables and chairs in the 4-H Building.
- * Pick-up Superintendent packet, ribbons, entry cards and rubber bands from 4-H Office on stage.
- * Greet judges as they arrive by 7:45 a.m. (Visual Arts) or 8:45 a.m. (Performing Arts)
- * As 4-H members enter their crafts, please check that only 4 exhibits are entered per class.
- * Assist 4-H members in filling out white entry cards.
- * Keep the judging process moving.
- * Keep walk-ways open through 4-H Building. If 4-H members are blocking please ask them to move.
- * Make judge as comfortable as possible. Get coffee, tea, water, or pop as needed.
- * If assisting judge write comments, mark cards and complete spotlighting awards.
- * Mark placing on both sides of entry card. Keep the large section and put small section on exhibit.
- * Encourage judges to complete the expense form. Take form to Michele on stage and a check will be written to give to the judge at the completion of judging.
- * Be sure to have superintendents at all areas of judging.
- * As judging finishes, sort cards by directions provided in superintendent's packet

- * Take cards to Michele on the stage when finished sorting.
- * **Visual Arts Only:** When all judging is completed, judges are to select 5 items for State Fair displays. See details in superintendent packet.
4-H members **must** be 9 years old before January 1 of current year. Also, select honorable mentions, creative/unique exhibits, these may include the younger 4-H members. Note only one exhibit per member.
- * When State Fair list, Honorable Mention, and creative/unique exhibits list is complete take to 4-H Office on stage. Exhibit cards are on the stage and will need to be made and placed on the exhibits from these lists.
- * After judging is completed assist in taking down tables and chairs.
