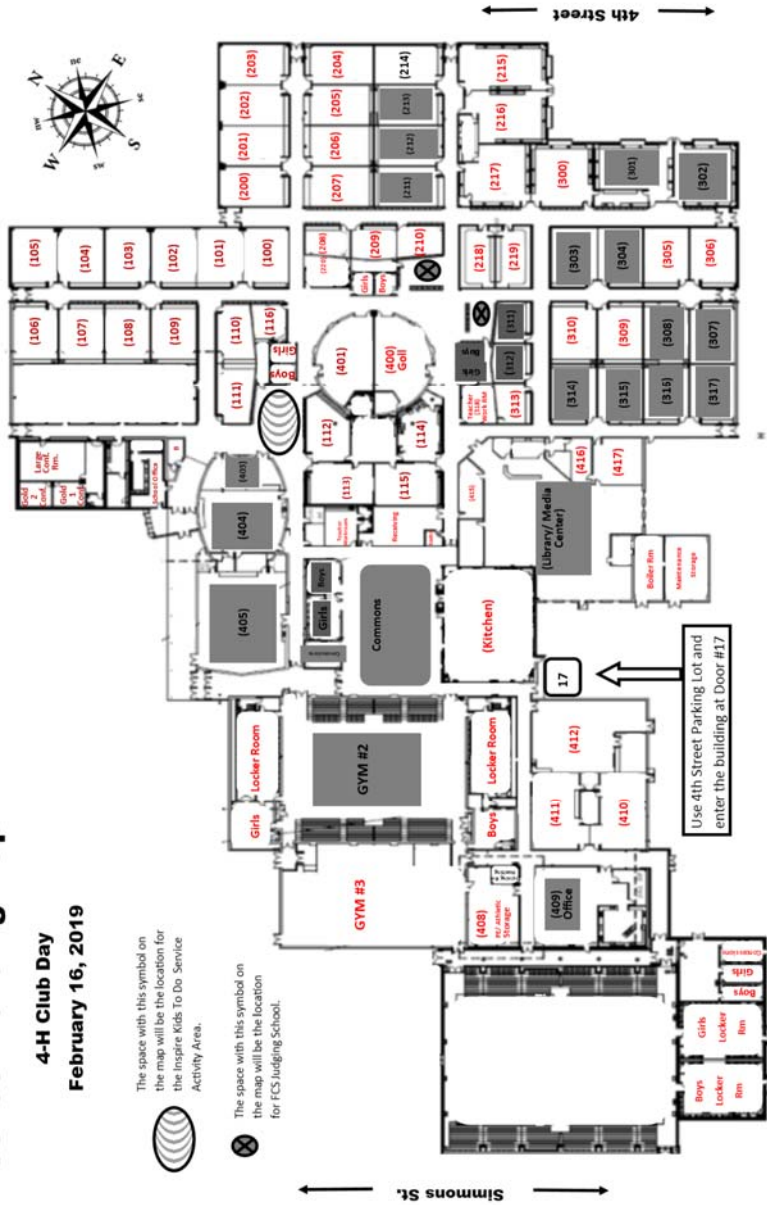

## COMMUNITY SERVICE PROJECTS

### OTTAWA COUNTY LOVE, INC. & BLESSING BOX

For this service project, we will be collecting ramen noodles for the Ottawa County Love, Inc. (an organization providing necessities and educational opportunities to those in need), and non-perishable foods, cold weather gear, and personal hygiene items which will be donated to a blessing box in the Salina area. The blessing box is stocked with items for homeless and individuals in need. The items needed for this service project include: socks, wash cloths, soap, gloves, hats, non-perishable foods (canned meat, canned vegetables, canned fruit, pudding or fruit cups, granola bars, pop-tarts, etc.), and ramen noodles.

### SALINA SHARES

As an extension of the districtwide Home Environment Project, we will be collecting items to be assembled into Home Starter Kits for people/families in need who may be starting over with their households through the Salina Shares program. Salina Shares began as a group simply extending acts of kindness and has developed into a multi-faceted program continuing to extend those acts of kindness in addition to meeting the needs of those in crisis situations or just trying to get back on their feet. When considering donations for this project, please note that new items are preferred. The districtwide project members will be assembling the kits at a later date, but the items needed are: laundry baskets, air mattresses with pumps (for those who don't have beds), blankets, dishes, pots/pans, silverware, towels, dish soap, multi-surface cleaner/wipes, toilet bowl cleaner/brush, toilet paper, & paper towels.

### INSPIRE KIDS TO DO SERVICE ACTIVITY AREA

From 8:30 a.m. until supplies run out, there will be a series of hands-on service projects. Youth service leaders will be facilitating a variety of activities as an opportunity for participants to stop by and make, build, or craft items that will be donated to local agencies and organizations. **Be Prepared for Run-Offs** – If you receive a purple on a demonstration, project talk or public speaking . . . you may choose to present your public presentation again for a chance to represent the District at 4-H Regional Club Day. **Regional run-offs will begin at 1:15 p.m.** Don't forget to check to see if you have made the run-offs before you leave. If you have made the run-offs, you will need to sign up for a time to do your demonstration, project talk or public speaking piece again.

**Public Speaking Participants** – Please bring two copies of your outline . . . one for the judge in the morning and another for run-offs. This will help eliminate confusion and panic if you make run-offs.

**Judges and Committee Room** – Room 409 will be designated just for the judges and committee members. Please be respectful of this.

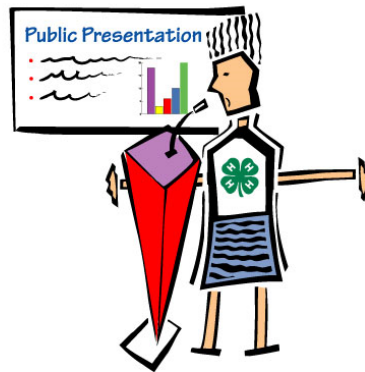
