- Preference will be given to applicants attending a Kansas college/university.
- Applicant must have been involved in 4-H for at least three years.
- Must turn in the most current 4-H Permanent Record regardless if you have been out of 4-H for a year or more.

SALINE COUNTY 4-H DEVELOPMENT FUND COLLEGE/UNIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIP

- This scholarship is based on 4-H experience and merit.
- Must be a graduating high school senior and a current 4-H member in Saline County with three years of 4-H
 experience.
- Must turn in most current 4-H Permanent Record.

SALINE COUNTY 4-H DEVELOPMENT FUND TECHNICAL/VOCATIONAL/TRADE/COMMUNITY COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP
